**Opening Plenary: *Patty Wetterling, U.S. advocate of children's safety***

*Twenty years after 11-year old Jacob Wetterling was abducted at gunpoint on a rural St. Joseph, MN road his family has not given up hope. Oct. 22, 1989 a masked gunman approached Jacob, his brother and their friend as they road their bikes home from the store. He took Jacob and ordered the other two to get down. Despite a massive manhunt and hundreds of leads, Jacob has never been found. Patty, established the first state sex offender registry back in 1994. Patty and her husband, Jerry, co-founded the Jacob Wetterling Resource Center.*
